

Notes on the HATS3 Executable File Diskette

At the C:\>, enter the Command: >a:\hats3

will call the compressed HATS3 file and the user will be prompted for an installation directory which will expand the compressed files to 2.1 MB. Compressed the HATS3 program uses 1.35 MB and fits on one HD 3.5" diskette. Distribute this diskette freely. Any disk copy program will copy the contents to a diskette which can be passed on to others.

HATS3- Hazards Analysis For Toxic Substances, Version 3

HATS3 is a menu-driven Harvard Graphics Screen Show presentation intended to be a self-directed orientation for emergency planners and responders new to the EPCRA program and as a refresher for those needing to review sections of the program. As packaged, the program is in a self-extracting compressed format as hats3.exe. This program will run in DOS, in Windows 3.1 or in Windows 95. The program will install in a directory of your choice (we suggest c:\hats) either directly from a 3.5" diskette or from the executable copied to your hard drive. To open from the diskette, the command is:

```
a:hats3
```

Any similar Windows "run" command will work.

The Hats directory will contain the Screen Show, HATS3, and hgplayer.exe which is required to run the screen show. Also contained are text files which provide supplementary data as explained in various modules of the screen show. To run the screen show, the basic command is:

```
c:\hats\hgplayer hats3.ply
```

A user can move through the program screen-by-screen or can move to elements of the program using the various Menu buttons. The [escape] key will allow you to leave the program at any time, as will the various "quit" buttons.
